This organisation supports for the salary for two teachers and a small amount for the snacks, note books etc., It was inaugurated in the month of February 2007.



During the summer vocation, few volunteers from Netherlands Mr. Iennhart, Miss. Esmee, Miss. Megan were with us to do the summer school for the children. The children were taught spoken English, rhymes etc. The children were taught regular lessons as a supplementary

activity. The note books of the children are checked every day.



They are monitored with the school activity. The progress is noted and encouragement is given to them every now and then.
